As you all know we are a nut free school, which means their food cannot contain nuts or be processed in a manufactory that has nuts. See our attached sheet with a list of some great nut-free lunch ideas. We also ask that all the children's lunches are cut and prepared for them to eat (sandwiches cut or the crust cut off, oranges peeled, apples sliced, easy mac prepared, ect.) to make our lunch time more time sufficient.

We would like to ask that your child keep his or her toys at home. Please honor this request. The only exception is items that correspond with our monthly unit. We encourage our friends to share educational treasures with the class (beehive, seashells, birds nest, etc.). We would like note that books are ALWAYS welcome in our classroom.

Here is a list of items your child will need in the Rainbow Fish Class; blanket and any other nap time necessities. We ask that each child has at least 2 changes of extra weather appropriate clothing, including socks and underwear!!! During the summer months we recommend the children have an extra pair of footwear in their cubby for when we have water play. Also, on rainy days we still go out for our outside time so please provide your child with appropriate rain gear (rain boots and a rain jacket). During our warmer months we also ask that parents bring their child in with sunscreen on and we will re-apply sunscreen in the afternoon before our afternoon outside time. Also, during the warmer months we are asking that your child come to school in playground appropriate footwear; no flip flops unless they have a back. Thank you for you cooperation.
